TAMEY LAU | BELOVED LOCAL FLORIST

With flowers spilling onto the sidewalk and cats nestled in her window, Tamey Lau turned a simple storefront into a living love letter to the neighbourhood. Her birdcages and quiet generosity have made her both florist and folklore in Mile End's story. We honour her memory and contribution to this great neighbourhood.



NAKUSET - INDIGENOUS ADVOCATE

A survivor of the Sixties Scoop, Nakuset turned her personal history into a powerful voice for urban Indigenous communities. From shelters to stages, she's made Mile End a louder, safer, and more visible place for those too often erased.



KHOA LÊ - FILMMAKER & CULTURAL CONNECTOR

With a camera in hand, Khoa Lê captures the poetic in the personal — stories of queerness, displacement, and belonging. His lens has helped redefine what it means to be seen in a neighbourhood shaped by many voices.



ANDY NULMAN - CULTURAL ENTREPRENEUR

Before Montreal became a global comedy hub, Andy Nulman was daring audiences to laugh at the unexpected. His trailblazing spirit helped launch Just for Laughs — and made Mile End a magnet for creative risk-takers.





Drawing on Mile End's rich cultural fabric, the mural tells a story of creativity, resilience, and transformation — celebrating the artists, entrepreneurs, and community members who continue to shape its identity.

TEXTILE TRIBUTE

The girl's clothing — her shirt, shoes, bag, and belt — features patterns inspired by the building's original use as a textile factory, honoring Mile End and Le Carré de Gaspé's industrial roots and the craftsmanship that thrived here.

DRAGON FLOWERS HOMAGE

A birdcage in the mural symbolizes Dragon Flowers and longtime florist Tamey Lau, whose vibrant storefront has brought life, color, and community spirit to Bernard Avenue for decades.


MORETHAN
